
Textured Moon





1.

Start by tracing a large circle (I used a bowl) on a piece of foil.

Cut out the circle, but keep the leftover/scrap (see next step for why!).





3.

Using the leftover/scrap as a guide, place coins inside the circle – these will create your moon's texture!

Place the cut circle on top of the coins and carefully press down around each coin to make the moon's craters!





5. Add glue around the moon's craters as shown.

6.

Now glue it to a piece of black construction paper.



7.

Add stars all around the moon. Do you remember the easy way I taught you? Make a **t** and then add an **x** on top of it!

8.

Now you're done! You've got an awesome textured moon!
